REQUIREMENTS :

Heavy duty mechanics is a skilled trade. Individuals can begin their careers as apprentices, working 80% of the time and attending technical training the other 20%. Once all four levels are completed, an individual attains their Red Seal Certification.

Class 1 or 3 License with airbrake endorsement preferred.

- Ability to read and follow technical instructions.
- Ability to work with little supervision.

- Perform safety inspections, documenting all defects and malfunctions.
- Skilled in using computers and electronic equipment to diagnose and solve mechanical and technical problems.
- Ability to use manuals and schematics.
- Ability to rebuild engines and major driveline components.
- Source parts and supplies when necessary.
