### REQUIREMENTS :

Welding is a skilled trade. You typically need a high school diploma or equivalent, combined with technical and on-the-job training, to enter the occupation.

Individuals can participate in a three-year apprenticeship program or a combination of over three years of work experience in the trade and some college or industry courses in welding is usually required to be eligible for trade certification.

Ability to wear all standard PPE (respirator, safety boots, CSA approved hard hat, safety vest, etc.)
