REQUIREMENTS :

Transport Truck Technicians are a skilled trade. Individuals can begin their careers as apprentices, working 80% of the time and attending technical training the other 20%. Once all four levels are completed, an individual attains their Red Seal Certification.

Class 1F License preferred.

JOB OVERVIEW

As a Transport Truck Technician your primary responsibility is to diagnose, service, assemble, repair, and maintain transport trucks and buses, including those with a gross weight of 4,500 kilograms or more. You will use your mechanical, electrical, and hydraulic systems expertise to troubleshoot issues and perform necessary repairs to ensure optimal functionality. Additionally, your role may involve conducting routine inspections, adhering to safety protocols, and efficiently managing repair tasks to minimize downtime.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Inspect and test gasoline and diesel-powered equipment for proper performance.
- Diagnose and repair truck and truck tractor engines, including but not limited to key operating systems such as power trains, transmissions, braking systems, and fuel and electrical systems.
- Maintain fleet trucks and equipment, conducting regular preventative maintenance and routine checks and adjustments to fluid levels, hoses, brakes, belts, etc.
- Perform safety inspections, documenting all defects, malfunctions, and when applicable, complete Periodic Mandatory Vehicle Inspection (PMVI) form.
- Source parts and supplies when necessary.
- All work must be completed within the company's safety guidelines.
- Complete appropriate documentation.
- Report and document any incidents encountered.
